1. 2007 SFA Dues for “Non-life” Members

Dues for Chapter 49, Arkansas Special Forces Association are due by January 31, 2007. Dues for 2007 are \$25.00 for active members if paid before December 31, 2006. If you are a current active member and do not pay dues by January 31, 2006, you will be placed in inactive status and dropped from the SFA “Drop” Roll, and will not receive the Drop and, will have to pay a reinstatement fee (\$40.00) to return to active membership. **Life members do not pay annual dues.**

2. 2006 Christmas Party

The Christmas Party will be held at the New VFW Post located at 2231 East Grand Hot Springs, AR 71901. The date is **Saturday, December 2, 2006**. **Happy Hour will be at 1700-1830 hrs and Dinner at 1900 hrs**. The hospitality room at the VFW will be open Friday evening, Saturday, and will be available for the Chapter meeting Sunday Morning.

The Registration Fee is **\$15.00** per person and includes beverages and the Saturday evening meal. Joe Mathews will be cooking Rib-Eye Steaks and Grilled Chicken Breasts. (See Menu below). Also, two waitresses will be on duty to help with the serving and clean up. We will have a Chapter bar in the meeting area. Again, beverages will be provided by the Chapter.

The VFW will have a band playing Friday and Saturday nights in the general purpose area and the bar prices are very reasonable. If, after the SF Party anyone that wants to join the dance, there is no cover charge. Also, the VFW will be serving a Sunday Morning Breakfast Buffet for \$6.00.

This year new laws have required that the meeting rooms at the VFW are designated "non smoking" areas. There are areas that are posted as smoking rooms such as the bar and dance area. We will have a smoking area under the tent where Joe Mathews will be cooking the steaks.

Since the motel is not next door to the VFW, Chapter 49 will provide a shuttle to and from the VFW and Knights Inn Motel for anyone who doesn't want to drive, but desires to consume wine and spirits at the Christmas Party. We want everyone to enjoy themselves in a safe environment.
